Winemaking

An exceptional season was marked by one of the most spectacular Marri blossom's we've ever seen. A wet winter set the tone for a slow start, but the sun came out on 4 September and remained for the season

with rain ceasing in November. Summer followed with warm days resulting in a magnificent ripening period with no disease or bird pressure. Once harvest started it was on for young and old, with the extended family and friends pitching in to help.

Pinot noir from the heart of Wilyabrup, on Peter and Jane Thompson's property, were our first grapes for 2022. Carefully handpicked on 19 February they were whole-bunch pressed then naturally fermented in barrel between 16-20°C. With no malolactic fermentation, and topped with chardonnay lees, the barrels were stirred every 3-4 weeks until July, then bottled in August 2022. The resulting wine has intense aromatics, vibrant fruit and succulent structure underpinned by natural acid.
